2017 Outdoor Monthly International Pistol Schedule and Program

May 6, June 3, July 8, August 5

Competition Open To: All Competitors

Location: 7250 West Crawfordsville Road, Indpls., IN 46224

Facilities: 23 point covered and lighted firing line in a park like environment. 50 yard line is fixed targets and 25 yard line are turning targets. Facility has a clubhouse with restrooms, meeting area with tables and chairs. Range is within 5 minutes of several restaurants, motels, groceries and gas stations.

Entries: Limited to 23 competitors in each match, 1 relay for each match and preference is given to competitors firing all three matches.

Time: Registration begins at 8:00 am EDT and continues until each match is full or competition begins. The order of events is as follows:

Free Pistol start 9:00 am EDT (Start of Preparation Time) to approximately 11:30 EDT

Lunch at conclusion of Free Pistol

Standard Pistol – 12:30 pm EDT (Start of Preparation Time – as allowed by conditions) followed by a 5 to 10 minute break and then the **Center-Fire / Sport Pistol** match until approximately 3:30 pm.

Entry Fees: \$10.00 per match. Additional fee for reporting to USA Shooting is \$6.00 for first match and \$3.00 for each additional match. Junior shooters pay only current reporting fees (i.e. \$4.50 to NRA and / the appropriate USA Shooting fee - whichever combination of reporting is desired)

Rules: Current NRA International Pistol Rules are in effect. **ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEAR EYE AND EAR PROTECTION.**

All Matches are Individual Matches and are NRA APPROVED and USA Shooting sanctioned matches. Scores will be reported to NRA, USAS, or both for record and classification purposes.

Classification: Currently all matches are fired as “Open – Unclassified”.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for High Junior if there is one firing in each event.

Program:

Free Pistol – Fired at 50 yards on stationary B-19 25/50yd Precision Targets, 60 shot match fired in 6 seventeen minute periods. This match is preceded by a 10 minute preparation period followed by a 17 minute sighting period with unlimited sighting shots. Targets are scored and repaired or replaced after each 10 shots (other than the sighter target which is replaced with first match target).

Standard Pistol – Fired at 25 yard turning targets on B19 25/50yd Precision Target, 60 shot match fired in three stages consisting of 4 series of 5 shot strings in 150 seconds each followed by 4 series of 5 shot strings in 20 seconds each followed by 4 series of 5 shot strings in 10 seconds each. This match begins with a 5 minute preparation period followed by a 5 shot sighting series in 150 seconds.

Center Fire / Women’s Sport Pistol – Fired at 25 yard turning targets. 30 shot precision stage is fired on B-19 25/50yd Precision Targets and 30 shot Rapid Fire Stage is fired on B-38 25yd Rapid Fire Target. This match begins with a 5 minute Preparation Period. The next period is a 5 minute Sighting series fired on the B19 target. Then the precision stage is fired in six 5 shot string periods of 5 minutes each. Targets are scored and repaired after each 10 shots. After the last precision string is fired the targets are changed to the B38 25yd Rapid fire target and the shooters fire a 5 shot sighter series in the duel style where the target faces for 3 seconds and then turns away for 7 seconds until the five shots are completed. The shooters then fire six 5 shot strings in the duel style scoring after each ten shots.

Scoring: Competitors will score the target of the competitor on their right. Scorers will record each individual shot value on score cards provided and **BOTH** scorer and competitor will sign score card before turning card in to range personnel at conclusion of each match.
