Intermediate Smallbore Rifle Clinic

as a part of the ISRPA Junior Rifle Clinic Series

July 24 – 27, 2020

Attention all Junior Smallbore Athletes!

ISRPA is pleased to announce that the 1st annual Intermediate Rifle Clinic will be held on Friday, July 24 through Monday, July 27 at Camp Atterbury in conjunction and partnership with the NRA National Matches.

CAMP PROGRAM AND OBJECTIVES: Participants must be between the ages of 12 to 19 and entering grades 7-12. The athlete must currently be shooting in three-position smallbore or three-position air rifle competition matches. Students who have not reached their 18th birthday by July 24, 2020, must be accompanied by an adult (age 21 or older). Participants will receive training with one-on-one interaction to ensure individualized learning opportunities.

Coaches will be certified by either the NRA or USA Shooting. Coaches are carefully selected based upon their technical ability and coaching experience. Instruction will focus on safety, reinforcing the fundamentals, and refining or building the shooting positions of prone, standing, and kneeling.

Camp will include instruction and competition. Competitions will include traditional 3X20 match as well as a Dewar Match. Competition will take place on the newly rebuilt smallbore ranges at Camp Atterbury. Camp will take place alongside the three-position portion of the NRA National Championships.

Cost of camp is \$250. Campers must provide their three-position smallbore target rifle (equipment and ammunition), Lodging for athletes is available free of charge. The clinic is limited to the first 20 athletes to register.

Head Coach, Gregg Rice, is licensed by the ISSF. The coaching will focus on intermediate instruction and will assume that athletes have some experience with the fundamentals of three position shooting.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY: The Intermediate Rifle Clinic is primarily designed for the intermediate athlete. Athletes need to bring their own target grade smallbore rifle. Athletes need to provide all the necessary equipment and ammunition. Athletes should have a smallbore rifle, a precision coat, pants, boots, and target grade smallbore ammunition. The clinic is designed for junior shooters who are rising grades 7-12.

ADULT SPONSORSHIP: Students who have not reached their 18th Birthday by July 24, 2020, must be accompanied by an adult sponsor (age 21 or older) who will have designated power of attorney.

LIMITED ENROLLMENT: Enrollment will be limited to 20 athletes. Athletes will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

APPLICATION AND FEES: Athletes should complete the attached application. Receipt of completed application will be acknowledged by email.

The camp registration fee is \$250 and includes administrative costs, four days of training, training materials, and on base lodging. The registration fee does not cover such costs as travel and food although athletes may participate in the meal plan (details to follow).

Applications, supplemental forms (Medial Release and Liability Waiver), and fees should be sent to the Indiana State Rifle and Pistol Association @ PO Box 40035, Indianapolis, IN 46240. Checks should be made payable to ISRPA.

In the case of cancellation by the athlete a refund, less 20%, administrative fee may be issued only if another participant is able to attend in their place. The application deadline is May 31, 2020. In the event that an athlete is unable to attend, athletes from the waiting list will be contacted to determine their continued interest in the camp as space becomes available. A waiting list will be kept, and applicants will be updated regarding their position in the queue.

CANCELLATION OF CAMP: ISRPA reserves the right to cancel the Intermediate Rifle Clinic if a minimum of 15 athletes have not registered. Cancellation notifications along with a full refund will be emailed to each registrant if the camp is canceled.

STAFF QUALIFICATIONS: All instruction and coaching will be conducted by current NCAA coaches, NCDS, or coaches with Advanced Certification through USA Shooting. Head Coach, Gregg Rice is licensed by the ISSF.

PUBLICITY: Enrollment in this clinic will occur primarily by word of mouth. Feel free to share the application and clinic information with other junior athletes. All necessary application materials are included in this packet or they can be found at www.ISRPA.org.

CAMP ACITIVITES: Camp activities will consist of three-position smallbore shooting at 50 and 100 yards. The camp will take place at Camp Atterbury on the newly renovated smallbore ranges. Orion Scoring system will be used. Targets will be scored and uploaded to the Orion website. Camp experiences are intended to build each of the three positions.

We are so excited to be offering this camp in conjunction with the NRA National Matches. These matches have much history and we are grateful to be a part of continuing this great tradition.
